#### Institutional Profile

The Instituto Universitario Patagónico de las Artes (IUPA) is the Public University of the Arts of the province of Rio Negro. It is officially recognized nationwide and its main headquarters are located in the city of General Roca, Río Negro.

The year 2015 marked a historic milestone when IUPA was granted official recognition by the National Executive Power (Decree No. 812/15), allowing the institution to position itself as a benchmark for public art education.

This made IUPA finally be able to grant university degrees, however the institution has a history dating back to the 1990's, when its founder Norberto Mario Rajneri made his long-cherished dream come true and became its first Rector.

Today, IUPA offers 29 degree programs officially recognized by the Ministry of Education.

Located in an area known as "the City of the Arts", IUPA has 59 fully equipped classrooms and studios with tools and instruments for masterclasses in each discipline. There is also a Library, a Cafeteria, and other service areas.
