▪ **Institutional Profile:**

The Universidad Nacional del Comahue (UNCo), founded in 1972, is a public university located in Argentine Patagonia Region and one of the few regional universities in the country. It has Academic Units in 16 locations in the provinces of Neuquén and Río Negro (12 Faculties, 1 School, 2 Regional Centers and 2 Settlements). Students can thus access an academic offer composed of more than 80 undergraduate and graduate degrees, and 45 postgraduate courses, which allow them to develop independent learning methods, access specific study methodologies and encourage teamwork and mutual collaboration, thus facilitating the transition from the University to professional life. In addition, UNCo has an important scientific-technological capacity through the activities of its research groups that develop projects in a multiplicity of disciplines, with around 254 research projects that group approximately 1775 researchers belonging to different Academic Units, Centers Scientists, of excellence and Institutes of double dependency with CONICET. Furthermore, UNCo develops actions of community strengthening and university extension through its territorial insertion in a permanent way, through different areas of cultural, artistic, recreational and sports expression that allow the University to integrate socially promoting the regional development of Patagonia.

The general institutional guidelines that frame the international activities, and that constitute a mission of reference for the development of the actions of the International Relations Undersecretary, is that of "incorporating the international dimension and integrating its actions in a strategic way to the functions, activities and actions developed by the University as a whole". That is, to understand, develop and include international activities as a transversal part of all functions, activities and actions developed by the University and integrate such actions in a strategic way to the University. In this way, the development of the international dimension in the different fields of action of the institution is proposed: research, academic training, extension, and others. In this way, a comprehensive vision of the international activities of the University throughout the institution is promoted, both in the central management units and in the different academic units, in order to integrate the international aspect in all the activities in order to comprehend and understand internationalization as part of university functions.
