



# Historical Background:

The creation of the Universidad Nacional de la Patagonia Austral was an aspiration for several decades. As a historical context, it is worthy of mention the decree of the city of Gobernador Gregores, who proposed the creation of University Centres with a technological orientation.

In 1962, the first Centre of Higher Studies attached to the Universidad Nacional del Sur was constituted becoming the first institutional precedent of higher education at university level in the region.

This Centre, which later became the Instituto Universitario de Santa Cruz, together with a series of non-university Centres of Higher Studies, formed the basis for the creation of the Universidad Federal de la Patagonia Austral, which from 1991 developed under the regime of provincial universities. The formal transference to a national jurisdiction took place in January 1996.

The pre-existing institutions organized themselves in 1987 with the aim of developing higher education in Southern Patagonia. This regional vocation made the newly created Province of Tierra del Fuego to formalise its participation in 1989 possible, by means of a Treaty signed by the Governors of the provinces, with the prospect that the Academic Units Campus would operate in four cities in Santacruz and Tierra del Fuego.

This long process of continuous growth was possible thanks to the constant support and encouragement of the communities of the southern continent, as well as the efforts of teachers, students, technical and administrative staff, which have allowed the development, growth and formalization of the Universidad Nacional de la Patagonia Austral. which was created by National Law N<sup>o</sup> 24.446, passed on 23 December 1994 and promulgated on 11 January 1995.



## Institucional Profile:

The main objective of the Universidad Nacional de la Patagonia Austral is to be aware and ensure the respond to the regional demands in the context of higher education, not only in relation to vocational training but also with the production of scientific and technological knowledge.

The UNPA is conceived as a strategic tool for regional growth, not only in professional training, but fundamentally in the production of scientific and technological knowledge. In this sense, its graduate and postgraduate academic proposal is open in areas such as: mining, in the Academic Units Campus located in the cities of Río Turbio and San Julián, accompanying the development of two of the most important mining basins in the country, one for coal and the other for gold in these two regions respectively. Tourism on-site, e-learning or mixed courses, in all the academic units campus. As Santa Cruz is a tourist province par excellence, with international attractions such as the Perito Moreno Glacier, Mount Fitz Roy, or the Deseado Estuary, this academic training become a main goal. At least but with no less importance those courses related to the care and conservation of natural resources, because, in addition, it has sixteen protected areas and three national parks.

Likewise, archaeology and history courses have an important growth, since Patagonia is a place which is rich in prehistoric legacies, fortunately well preserved, such as Las Cuevas de las Manos and the Petrified Forest -close to the Caleta Olivia Unit- declared World Heritage by UNESCO.
